“AMANDA” is a 19-year-old young woman referred to Wings through the Crime Victims Center of Chester County. In her own words, she is “just a sweet, determined person who can't wait to be successful,” and is attending CAT-Brandywine to become a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).

For Amanda's job interview, Wings suggests the following:

- Black pants, size 1X (18/20)
- Coordinating shell/top, size 1X (18/20)
- Matching sweater/lightweight jacket, size 1X (18/20)
- Bra, size 38DD
- Shoes, size 10-wide
- Black handbag
- Jewelry – necklace, earrings

“DESIREE” is a 21-year-old mother of one child, who seeks “a better paying job and to be able to take care of my family.” She was referred to Wings by Phoenixville Area Community Services (PACS) and hopes to gain employment as a nurse's aide.

For Desiree's job interview, Wings suggests the following:

- Dark pants, size XS (0/2)
- Coordinating shell/top, size XS (0/2)
- Matching sweater/lightweight jacket, size XS (0/2)
- Bra, size 34C
- Shoes, size 7
- Coordinating handbag
- Jewelry – necklace, earrings

“LAURA” is a 25-year-old single mother of one child living in Coatesville. She is a domestic abuse survivor and is working to earn her General Equivalency Diploma (GED). Laura was referred to Wings by the EARN Center (Employment Advancement and Retention Network). She “loves to learn, loves her daughter, and would love to go back to school.”

For Laura's job interview, Wings suggests the following:

- Black or gray pants, size L (12)
- Coordinating shell/top, size L (14)
- Matching sweater/lightweight jacket, size L (14)
- Bra, size 34D
- Shoes, black, size 8 1/2
- Black handbag
- Jewelry – necklace, earrings

“VICTORIA” is a 32-year-old mother of four with a Bachelor's degree in computer science. She loves to cook and enjoys singing in her church choir. Victoria recently lost her job due to company downsizing and was referred to Wings through CareerLink of Chester County.

For Victoria's job interview, Wings suggests the following:

- Dark pants, size L (14) or XL (16)
- Coordinating shell/top, size XL (16)
- Matching sweater/lightweight jacket, size XL (16)
- Bra, size 38D
- Shoes, size 9 1/2
- Coordinating handbag
- Jewelry – necklace, earrings
